WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

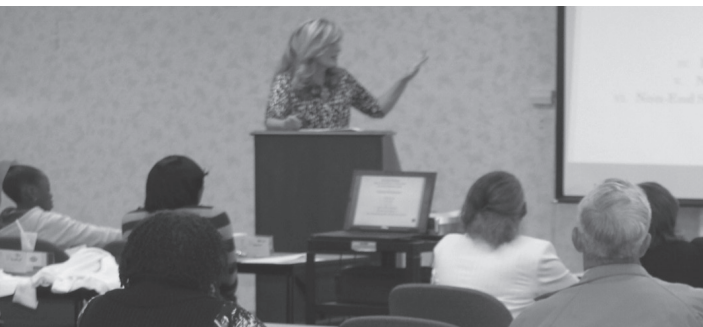
The conference is for dialysis patients, kidney transplant patients, kidney patient family members and/or caregivers.
